IMAGING OVERVIEW

X-ray examination of the leg including carpus.

NOTES

1. Mini-fragment dorsally in the fetlock of the left front leg, right front leg, and left hind leg.

VETERINARY ASSESSMENT

Based on a veterinary assessment, there is a normal risk that the horse's X-ray status as of this date will affect the horse's intended use. Ref. Point 1.

PREREQUISITES FOR THE ASSESSMENT

It is assumed that the horse is intended for trotting. The assessment is based on the assumption that the horse is clinically healthy with no lameness or swelling, normally rideable and appropriately trained for its age with a documented competition history if available. The X-ray findings can lead to insurance exclusions and can affect the potential resale value. It is assumed that compromised image quality does not obscure relevant X-ray changes. The assessment was made by veterinarian Martin Hjorth, Højgård Horse Hospital.
